In order to be named to this list, companies had to have met at least "average" scores in each of TAA's five quantitative trust drivers that comprise its FACTS® Framework: Financial stability and strength, Accounting conservativeness, Corporate integrity, Transparency and Sustainability.

Nike and Progressive Corp. have topped their sectors for three years running.

TAA's methodology is unique. Data is compiled independently and companies do not participate in the analysis. They do not know they are being analyzed. The framework was conceived and developed in 2008 and is "the most holistic and comprehensive trust "health" checkup for public companies," according to Kimmel. She believes that "Values-based companies place high priority on trustworthy behavior. Furthermore, industry is not destiny. Even in the least trustworthy sectors, companies like Progressive Corp. are maintaining high scores in low score sectors."
